442/1/25 REPORT FROM DISTRICT & COUNTY COUNCILLOR STEVE CRISWELL

Parkhall Road drainage work will begin on the 3rd February, with road surfaces made good after repair work has been completed. Work to resurface the whole road will be undertaken as a new process.

An update regarding the Devolution of Local Government Review was offered; there will be many changes over the next 2-3 years regarding County and District Councils and the way in which they

operate. Two-tier local authorities are required to be unitary by the end of this parliament (2029). The process should not affect town and parish councils with hopes that services will remain unaffected.
